General Rules and Regulations

ALL MARKET ANIMALS WILL BE WEIGHED WHEN UNLOADED

- Each animal & poultry shown at the fair must be preregistered and post-marked no later than July 15, 2021.
 Registration forms are to be mailed to Angie Parks 14668 County Rd. 517 Dexter, MO 63841, or emailed to
 angieparks39@gmail.com. There will be a \$50/head late fee charged per animal. Late entries must be delivered
 with fee to Angie Parks no later than noon on August 1. Post-mark does not apply to late entries. The livestock
 chairman and livestock co-chairman reserve the right to meet with all exhibitors of market animals to see and
 tag the animal if necessary.
- 2. 4-H/FFA classes are open to 4-H & FFA chapter members who live in Stoddard County and/or are a member of a Stoddard County 4-H or FFA chapter. Members entering livestock must be paid up active members in their chapters or clubs in order to be eligible to show, sell or receive premiums. Active, paid-up status will be verified (in case of question) with the FFA or 4-H advisors.
- 3. Open class entries are open to the state. There is no age limit for showing rabbits and poultry. Youth must be age 6 to show sheep, goats, hogs and cattle.
- 4. Any question of sickness in exhibited livestock will be resolved by inspection by a DVM. Sick animals will be removed upon the recommendation of the veterinarian.
- 5. Entries will be accepted on Monday, Sept. 20, 2021 from 3 pm-7 pm for both large and small animals. There will be a small animal show during check-in. This includes all rabbits, cavies and poultry with the exception of geese and turkeys. Each exhibitor must remove the animal from the cage and place it on a table for judging without help from anyone else. The animal will not be exhibited at the fair if the exhibitor is unable to do this.
- 6. Livestock may be checked out between the hours of 8 am-1 pm on Sunday, Sept. 26, 2021.
- 7. Each exhibitor must show their own animal in each class unless they have more than one animal in the same class; then, they may choose someone to exhibit the extra animal for them.
- 8. All judging will be done by the Danish system, which includes blue, red, and white ribbon groups. Each animal will be judged on its own merit. All ribbons and premiums will be awarded at the judge's discretion. The decision of the judge is final and irrevocable. In any show where there is only one entry, the judge reserves the right to award less than first premium, if entry does not warrant the same.
- 9. Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class number, with the exception of market animals. Exhibitors in market class will be limited to showing not more than two market steers, two market hogs, two market lambs and two market goats. Up to four market entries per species may be listed on the registration form, but only two may be chosen to show and brought to fairgrounds. Only **ONE** market animal per species will be allowed to sell at the Stoddard County 4-H & FFA Livestock Auction.
- 10. Each animal may only be shown under ONE livestock class number.
- 11. Market weight classes will be set after animals are weighed at check-in on Monday Sept. 20.
- 12. There will be an OPTIONAL weigh-in for market animals on Saturday July 31, 2021 at the fairgrounds. Call Bobby Harmon at 208-0452 by July 24 to schedule an appointment if you are interested in this.
- 13. All 4-H & FFA livestock exhibitors must be certified & show proof with livestock registration due by July 15, 2021 that they have completed the Show-Me Quality Assurance (SMQA) program. No exhibitor will be allowed to show or sell any species of animal or poultry without this certification available at http://agebb.missouri.edu/smqa/
- 14. A quorum of the livestock committee may reserve the right to discontinue any livestock activity in the event of bad weather or other unavoidable causes.
- 15. The time between shows will be held to ten minutes after the previous show, no exceptions.
- 16. Only the judge, Livestock Chairman, Livestock Co-Chairman, designated individuals and exhibitor may be in the ring during the shows.

- 17. No responsibility will be taken in case of fire, theft, damage, injury or death of any person, animal or article.
- 18. Each livestock exhibitor is responsible for the feeding and watering daily of their livestock and for furnishing the bedding, feed, water, water bucket and feed bucket. Place used bedding east of south livestock building.
- 19. Only exhibitors will be allowed to stay and care for livestock.
- 20. Entries must, in all cases, be made in the clerk's books and entry tags attached before animals will be permitted to compete for premiums.
- 21. Leaders of FFA and 4-H will be responsible for the conduct of their members. Misconduct means withdrawal of exhibits. Parents will assume responsibility for youth ages seven and under. In accordance with the state 4-H office, youth enrolled as 4-H Clover Kids will not be eligible to show or sell in any livestock category.
- 22. Entry tags must be fully completed by Monday, Sept. 20 at 7 pm. Small animal tags should be attached to the animal's cage. Large animal tags should be turned in to committee chairman. ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBIT TAGS MUST HAVE CLASS NUMBER AND BREED LISTED. EXAMPLE: 617F BLACK ANGUS
- 23. Point schedule is the same for Open, 4-H and FFA.
- 24. Exhibitor must be present for animal to show.
- 25. Animals not within weight requirements can show, but not sell at auction.
- 26. Per State of Missouri rules, all sheep and goats must have health papers from a DVM and official USDA scrapie tags. No health papers are required for other animals and poultry.
- 27. The sheep and goat show will be held on Wednesday, Sept. 22 at 6 pm. The cattle and swine show will be held Thursday, Sept. 23 at 6 pm.

4-H & FFA LIVESTOCK SALE GUIDELINES

- 1. The 4-H & FFA Sale is sponsored by the Stoddard County Fair Board.
- 2. Sale is open to 4-H & FFA exhibitors ONLY.
- 3. Sell order will be based on placing in show. Only **ONE** market animal per species may be sold.
- 4. The Stoddard County Fair Board will collect payment from the buyer and distribute checks as soon as all money is collected.
- 5. Livestock will sell by local market guidelines.
- 6. Exhibitors must be present at livestock auction for livestock to show and sell.
- 7. There will be no charity auction at the end of sale.
- 8. A market animal can be shown and sold at another fair and still be qualified to be shown and sold at the Stoddard County Fair, providing that it was not a terminal sale and meets the ownership requirements.
- 9. Animals not within weight requirements can show, but not sell at auction.
